

MEDLOCK PRIMARY SCHOOL

In Autumn Term 1 Year 1 will be learning about houses and homes.

Literacy Development

We will be learning the vocabulary needed to label the furniture in a house and produce an information booklet. We will retell the story of the three little pigs, and we will learn to follow and write instructions.

Mathematical Development.

We will be focusing on number fluency within 20 this half term. This will include counting within 20, place value within 20 and addition and subtraction within 20.

Understanding the World

Our focus this term is on houses and homes. Children will explore a variety of houses and homes in our local area. We will learn the vocabulary needed to describe different houses and homes. We will compare and contrast different houses and homes, from the past. In science we will be testing different materials too.

Expressive art and Design

We will be exploring art and design through our continuous provision and through our experience of the week. We will design and evaluate houses for little pigs. We will create art with natural materials, in response to our core texts. In the environment, children will have the opportunity to investigate different artists and create their own pieces.

Communication, Language, Literacy

The children will continue to develop their language skills through exploring the continuous provision. We will be developing talk through daily class discussions e.g. talking about seasons and weather. If needed the children will also be taking part in Wellcomm interventions. This will support their understanding of spoken word. The children will also be taking part in small group writing and reading practice sessions. Phonics sessions and catch up sessions will also happen daily.

Physical Development

We will have specialist PE coaching this term. This will focus on developing a wider range of movements in PE. We will have opportunities to further this development in our Year One outdoor area. We will build on the work in Reception on developing the children's fine motor skills to help support their writing.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we will focus on the transition into year one, how we are feeling and what makes us special. This will include responsive PSE sessions to the children's needs.
